I am writing in response to the alleged theft affecting TJ's accounts described in Principal Evan Glazer's March 5, 2010 email, and widely reported in the press.

The Thomas Jefferson Partnership Fund exists for the purpose of raising funds and soliciting gifts to support and advance TJ's educational mission. The Fund is a private, non-profit educational foundation that exists as a separate entity from the school. We maintain separate bank accounts, and our accounts are audited by a separate auditing firm.

Contributions and other support generated by the Partnership Fund are transferred to the School for the purpose of acquiring a specific technology or equipment or for the purpose of supporting a designated activity, and always at the specific request of the School. There is no indication at this stage of the investigation that any funds donated to TJ through the Partnership Fund have been misappropriated by the alleged theft of funds from School accounts.
